- a. 2021 Point in Time Count
- b. HMIS Software
  - i Consider switch from Clarity Human Services HMIS software to Apricot HMIS
  - Apricot is currently being used for the Coordinated Entry System; this will allow the systems to be merged into a single system
  - Apricot also includes a mobile PIT Count feature that will allow surveyors to enter data directly into the system and will attach GPS data to surveys entered.

**SUGGESTED ACTION:** Authorize Empower Tehama, as the HMIS Lead Agency, to enter an agreement with Social Solutions, Inc. to provide Apricot HMIS, CES and PIT Count software.
