Andrea C. Curry
  - a. **2020 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Balance of State Program**
    - i. 2021 ESG - [NOFA](#) was released on August 17, 2021, with submission deadline in October 19.
    - ii. Eligible for \$139,800 in Non-Competitive Rapid Rehousing funding.
    - iii. Eligible to recommend up to two applications into the competitive component.
    - iv. NOFA process again requires that CoCs implement process for selecting up to two providers to recommend for the non-competitive RRH allocation and up to two applications to recommend into the regional competition. Sample of 2020's local selection process documents provided as an Agenda attachment.  
**SUGGESTED ACTION:** Authorize updating of 2020's local selection process to be used for 2021.
  - b. **HUD Continuum of Care Program Application**
    - i. 2021 CoC [NOFO](#) was released on August 18, 2021 with a submission deadline of November 16.
    - ii. Local selection process – must be completed by October 15.  
**SUGGESTED ACTION:** Authorize updating of 2019's local selection process to be used for 2021.
  - c. **Homeless Housing, Assistance and Prevention (HHAP)**
    - i. HHAP-3 and HHAP-4 announced as part of \$12B funding to address homelessness as part of new California budget. Estimated that Tehama CoC will be eligible for about \$425K in each round, County of Tehama estimated to be eligible for about \$400K in each round.
